THIS DEED OF TRUST executed at Madras, on
this 24th day of OCTOBER 1983,

WITNESSETH as follows:-

WHEREAS the FOUNDER herein is desirous
of establishing a public Charitable Trust to provide
Education and Medical relief to the poor and needy

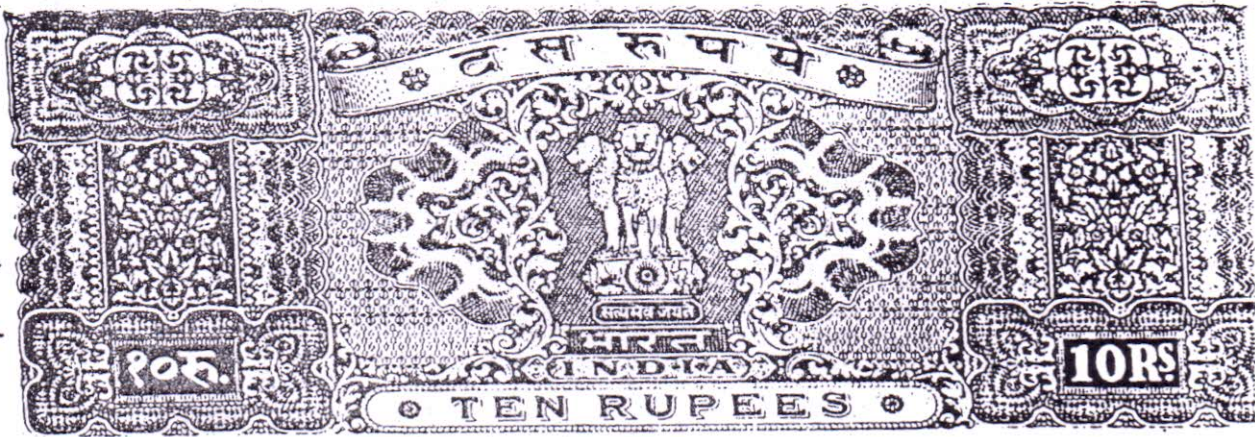



public and for assisting them for their education and medical needs by giving medical aids, free scholarships, and distributing text books, note books etc., free and for the other objects constituted hereunder and WHEREAS the FOUNDER of the Trust has with the aforesaid objects in view created a Trust on this 24th day of OCTOBER 1983 and has accordingly given a donation of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees one thousand only) for the above objects and constitution of the Trust and WHEREAS the FOUNDER is desirous of executing a regular Trust Deed.

NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH as

follows:-



11 The FOUNDER of the Trust doth hereby create and constitute a Charitable Trust for the purposes and objects hereinafter detailed and which are to be performed and carried on within the territories of the Indian Union.

2. The objects and purposes of the Trust are:

- (a) To provide medical aid to the poor and needy public irrespective of caste creed or religion in time of distress and need.
- (b) To establish, maintain, run, develop, improve, extend, grant donate for and to aid and assist in the establishment, maintenance, running, development, improvement and extension of education and medical institutions, technical Industrial and otherwise, including Hospitals, Dispensaries, Schools, Colleges, Polytechnics and Research Institutions and Associations, Workshops, etc., and Hostels for the benefit of students of such Institutions without distinctions of caste, creed or religion and to award scholarships for the study, research and apprenticeship for all or any of the said purposes.
- (c) To establish maintain, run, develop, improve, construct, extend, grand donation for and to



aid in the establishment maintenance, running, developing, improving, constructing and extending Educational Institution or Institutions, Polytechnics and other Institutions for imparting education to the General Public or to the student population in particular irrespective of caste, creed or religion.

- (d) To establish, maintain, run, develop, improve, extend, grant, donations for and to aid in the establishment maintenance, running, development, improvement and extension of Libraries, Reading Rooms, Recreation Centres and other facilities as are calculated to be of use in imparting education and medical services to the General public or to the student population in particular.
- (e) To give donations to educational institutions of any kind including technical institutions for creating endowments, for giving scholarships to the students and for distributing prizes to the students irrespective of caste, creed or religion.
- (f) To give grants and donations to the poor and needy students for procuring them their school uniforms or dresses or for purchasing text books, note books, instruments or any learning aids.

- (g) To establish, maintain, run, expand, construct and aid in the establishment, running, maintenance or construction of a Hostel or hostels, hospitals or dispensaries for the benefit of the needy and poor, free or at concessional rates irrespective of caste, creed or religion.
- (h) To give all necessary assistance for the disabled persons, deaf, dumb, mute etc., by way of financial assistance or any other assistance in kind by purchasing and supplying them necessary equipments etc., or any other assistance in kind by purchasing and supplying them necessary equipments etc., or any other type of assistance required by them.
- (i) To give donations to the poor and needy irrespective of caste, creed or religion in time of distress or need.
- (j) To encourage studies of all faculties and to institute prizes, endowments, shields, Rolling Trophies etc., for students in any School, College or Educational Institutions.
- (k) To arrange for and conduct poor feeding at place or places where people of all sections congregate on festive occasions with the approval of the Trustees in their meeting.

- (l) To do any other act or give any other assistance to aid the student community or the poor and weaker sections of the society as a whole in any form without any distinctions of caste, creed or religion.
- (m) To conduct and maintain free Medical centres and Eye camps including Surgery for the poor sections of Society.
- (n) To establish or assist in the establishment of Goshalas for Cows, Oxen, Buffalos, etc.
- (o) To arrange water supply for the Goshalas etc., etc., where animals are reared.
- (p) To propagate the ideals of Ahimsa (Non-Violence) and love for all living beings.
- (q) To alleviate the sufferings of destitute human being and animals and ameliorate their condition.
- (r) To establish and maintain educational institutions for giving moral and human education.
- (s) To establish and maintain hospitals for human beings as well as for animals.
- (t) To provide refuge for destitute human beings and animals.

- (u) To establish and/or aid other institutions engaged in the advancement of study of or research in Sanskrit, Vedas, Upanishads etc. works of great Acharya, Sanits and Scholars in Indian Philosophy.
- (v) To establish and maintain homes for the poor destitutes and deserving students and to promote their education or training by grant of scholarships, studentships or fellowships.
- (w) To celebrate or aid in the celebration or festivals in commemoration of great saints of any religion, Acharyas, Scholars, Philosophers, etc. by way of aiding and relieving the indigent scholars and to aid students, teachers, vidwans, engaged in the study of sanskrit, Indian Philosophy by giving them stipends, books, fees and medical aid and running free hostels.
- (x) To give aid to other institutions engaged in the advancement of blind and deaf and also other handicapped persons and also to other institutions to maintain co-samrakshna and poor feeding.
- (y) To provide food, Blankets and clothing to the flood and cyclone vixtims.

- (z) To construct Bus Shelters for the convenience of the public.
- (aa) To provide drinking water facilities to the public at large.
- (bb) To establish, maintain, run and administer hospitals, nursing homes, medical relief centres, dispensaries and such other institutions as may be found necessary and feasible to provide medical relief and treatment to the poor and needy public and to maintain ambulance for carrying on the primary purpose of the trust viz., relief of poor and medical relief.
- (cc) To institute, conduct, promote scientific and or medical research on all matters concerning and in particular of diseases, ailments, infection, epidemic, treatment etc., for carrying on the primary purpose of the trust viz., relief of poor and needy.
- (dd) To propagate and conduct teaching institutions in respect of objects set out above for nurses, doctors and students concerned with medicines for carrying on the primary purpose of the Trust viz., relief poor and to the poor and needy.

- (ee) To acquire, purchase, hold, take on lease or hire any property buildings, lands securities any kind of movable or immovable properties to use for the purpose of and in fulfilment of the objects of the trust.
- (ff) To produce, print, publish, circulate and distribute such literary materials in the form of books, periodicals, journals, circulate letters in such language or languages as may be found necessary or useful or conducive to the fulfillment of the objects set out above.
- (gg) To accept subscriptions and donations, devises and bequests of movable and immovable property objects to charges or otherwise for all or any of the proposes aforesaid and redeem charges created by donors from out of the income or property of the Trust.
- (hh) To acquire, by accepting as gift, purchase, lease, exchange or otherwise lands, buildings as structures of any tenure or description and to build constructions on lands and extend, improve and repair buildings and structures and otherwise deal with the property for the purposes aforesaid or any of them.
- (ii) To receive gifts donations and contributions whether in cash or in kind.

3. The above objects shall be independent of each other and the Trustees hereinafter constituted may, from time to time apply the income, profit and funds of the Trust for carrying out the objects of the Trust in the Territories of the Union of India.

4. The Founder of the Trust shall be the Founder Trustee and shall be a permanent Trustee for life. After his life time his eldest male child shall succeed to the place and so on. If there is no male issue for any Founder Trustee then the eldest female issue shall be the Trustee. If there is no issue for any Founder Trustee then such Trustee shall appoint and fix his or her successor during his or her life time itself.

5. The Founder Trustee doth hereby appoint and co-opt the following three persons as Trustees.

- (1) Mrs. ANANDAM AMMAL, wife of Sri T. Kalasalingam, aged 50 years, and residing at No.14, Sriman Srinivasan Road, Alwarpet, Madras-600 018,
- (2) Sri K.SRIDHARAN, son of T.Kalasalingam, aged about 21 years, residing at No.14, Sriman Srinivasan Road, Alwarpet, Madras 600 018,
- (3) Sri BALASIGAMANI, son of Gurusamy aged about 39 years, residing at No.3, Second Main Road, Ramakrishna Nagar, Madras 600 028,

6. The Founder Trustee and the other two Trustees appointed above shall form the Board of Trustees. The Board shall consist of at least three Trustees including the Founder Trustee. The other Trustees may be appointed or co-opted by the Board in the meeting or meetings.

7. The Trust shall be named as "KALASALINGAM AND ANANDAM AMMAL CHARITIES" and shall function at 14, ~~Brihan~~ Srinivasan Road, Alwarpet, Madras-600 018 or such other place or places as fixed by the Board of Trustees from time to time.

8. The Board of Trustees shall act, maintain and administer the Trust. If any of the Trustees other than the Founder Trustee dies or cease to be a Trustee or incapacitated to act as a Trustee, then the other Trustees shall be entitled to co-opt in the place of such dead or incapacitated Trustee any one from the family of the Founder Trustee.

9. Sri T.KALASALINGAM the Founder Trustee shall be the Managing Trustee and shall be the Chairman of the Board of Trustees and shall preside over the meetings of the Board and shall have a casting vote in cases of equal division in voting.

10. The Trustees shall maintain proper accounts and shall adopt the official year as the accounting

year of the Trust and shall close accounts of the Trust on the 31st day of March every year.

11. The Trustees if they start any institution or institutions anywhere they may, if they so desire appoint a sub-committee to look after the day-to-day administration of the institutions. All the Trustees including the Managing Trustee shall be the Ex-Officio Members of such committee.

12. The Board of Trustees shall decide the co-operation of the committee regarding the strength power, duties etc., etc.

13. The Founder Trustee shall hold the Office for life unless he is removed by the Board from Office for subversive activities or for contravening the objects of the Trust.

14. The Trustees may meet together for the despatch of the business of the Trust as often as they deem necessary.

15. A minutes book shall be regularly maintained and the resolutions passed at the meeting of the Trustees or by circulation shall be recorded and signed by all the Trustees present.

16. The Trustees shall meet the necessary expenditure and other outgoings of the Trust and


shall try to limit the same within the income from the investments of the Trust Funds.

17. The Trustees shall have the power to receive and accept contribution in money or property of any kind whether by way of additions to the Trust funds generally or for one or more specific objects of the Trust and such contributions shall be dealt with either as capital or as income according to the directions of the donors at the time of the gift or contribution and the trustee shall do all things as may be necessary to act upto the wishes or such donors.

18. The Trustees shall be entitled to invest the funds, monies and properties of the Trust in any manner they deem fit in immovable properties or in deposits with banks or with any banking establishments and they shall also be empowered to change the banks every now and then as and when they deem fit and proper. The investments so done shall at no time contravene the provisions of Sections 11 to 13 of the Income-tax Act 1961.

19. The Trustees shall as far as possible meet the commitments of the Trust from the income of the Trust fund investments and shall avoid to enroach or spend from the capital funds.

20. The Trust shall have a bank account or accounts in the name of the trust with any bank or



banks and the same shall be operated upon by any one of the Trustees acting for and on behalf of the Trust.

21. All investments, deposits and properties of the Trust shall be taken and obtained in the name of the Trust and not in the individual name or names of the Trustees.

22. The Trustees shall arrange for the maintenance of correct and proper accounts of all the receipts and disbursements and for the audit of accounts of the Trust every year.

23. The Trustees shall have the power to appoint the necessary establishments and members of the staff for the proper administration of the Trust funds and properties and are authorised to incur the necessary expenditure for the same.

24. The Trustees shall have the power to apply for and obtain grants or loans from the Governments, local authority or other authorities, banks, companies, firms, individuals and institutions on such terms and conditions as they may think fit in regard to security and shall for this purpose be entitled to execute such mortgage or charge on the properties of the trust as may be necessary.

25. In case of dissolution or determination of the Trust the corpus and its accumulations upto

the date of such dissolution or determination shall be transferred to a Charitable Trust having similar objects.

26. It is hereby declare that the TRUST IS IRREVOCABLE.
